5. Presentation of design options for McCurdy Park by Kayla Copeland of Copeland Design Collective
 - a. A topographical survey was completed showing the west and southwest being an undevelopable area
 - b. The basketball court areas will not be disturbed during the design concept process
 - c. Copeland Design Collective developed four different concepts
 - d. CDC wants to focus on soccer fields, a pool, and parking, with each concept having a varying
 - e. Other misc. amenities are available for each designs
 - i. Concept A 5.9 million with a focus on amenities- Est. 47-62 parking spots
 1. Practice turf and graded soccer fields with two fields, irrigation, fencing and lights.
 2. Pool has a pool house and restroom to hold 150 capacity (for all pool sizes)
 3. 20 X 20 Shade shelters for families and picnic tables and 1 large shade shelter suitable for family reunions or parties, large playground, restrooms, and availability for small concession with room for a smaller skate plaza
 4. Delta transit/pick up area
 - ii. Concept B 6.1 million with a focus on soccer fields- Est 62 parking spots
 1. Four soccer fields, center parking lot
 2. Pool will take up a quarter of the space with a capacity of 150
 3. Two large shelter areas, opportunities for food truck and splash pad
 - iii. Concept C 5.7 million with a focus on parking- est. 100 parking spots
 1. Two soccer fields size u14 (for all soccer fields)
 2. Median pool, playground area with two picnic shelters
 - iv. Concept D 5.1 million - est. 54 parking spots
 1. Green space on one side and amenities on the other side
 2. Three soccer fields
 3. Toddler playground
 - f. A survey was available for all attendees to rank their concept from most preferable to least preferable
6. Opportunities and constraint discussion for McCurdy Park concept
 - a. Concept A was most favorable with discussions to remove the food court and redesign pool for a larger plan. City Manager suggests to add a pickle ball court and additional parking.
